

As of the 25th May 2018, the new European regulation concerning data protection comes into effect.

The following website is a resource to educate the public about the main elements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR): <https://www.eugdpr.org>

This is important because personal details of registered users on this website are stored in a database with the website hosting provider.

If you have been registered as a league administrator, team captain or additional contact on this website, then the following details are recorded in this database: Name, mobile and/or landline telephone number, address of playing venue.

If a team captain has made a request for a member of their team to receive match results by email correspondence, then a name and email address is saved in the database for the individual. The team captain also has the ability to upload one profile photo for each member of their team and these photos are only visible to team captains when they log into their account and select an option to view an individual match result. Team captains must only upload a profile photo if they have the express permission of an individual to do so.

Email notifications may be sent to a team captain or league administrator relating to a league/cup fixture or result, or change of personal details of the team, team captain or additional team contact. The name of team members who have participated in a league/cup match may also be published in email correspondence relating to their team match result. Also, administrators and team captains are able to view general match statistics for each member of their team, where those members have participated in league matches but these statistics reflect on the individual's performance as part of a team.

Individual contact details held in the database are only visible to captains who log into their team account, this is done to help protect personal data, however general contact details regarding a team and their playing venue are visible to the public and this data may also include contact details such as a telephone number and/or email address.

Contact details stored in the database are stored as long as the team or individual team member is registered with the league and it is the responsibility of the league administration to maintain or delete contact details of a team or team member.

Personal details saved in the database are not shared with third parties and are intended to be used for the sole purpose of allowing the league website to run as smoothly as possible.

The "Contact Us" form will send an email to the primary league administrator and website owner (Alexander Harrison) and details submitted in this form are not recorded in the website database.

Please also note it is possible that the league administration publish information in pdf or word documents on this website and it is the responsibility of the league administration to ensure any personal data published in these documents are in accordance with GDPR.

If you are not happy with the information that is stored by this website or have any questions, then please don't hesitate to contact the league administration by using the "Contact Us" form.

If a dispute is raised and a resolution can't be found, then the website owner and/or league administration will ensure that personal details of the user in question are removed from the website database. If the dispute relates to documentation published by the league administration, the website owner will be excluded from the complaints process but may assist to remove documentation at the request of the league administration.
